

LASTING POWERS OF ATTORNEYS PRICE GUIDE

Lasting Powers of Attorneys ("LPAs") are power of attorneys under which an individual (the "Grantor") confers on the attorney authority to make decisions on their behalf. This authority continues even if the Grantor no longer has capacity.

LPAS

Health and Welfare LPAs enable decisions to be made about your personal wellbeing in the event that you lose capacity.

Property and Financial Affairs LPAs enable decisions to be made about your financial affairs when you have capacity or in the event that you lose capacity.

ATTORNEYS

An attorney can be any individual who has reached 18, who has not had bankruptcy proceedings issued against them in the 10 years proceeding their appointment.

For a property and financial affairs LPA, you can appoint a Guernsey licenced fiduciary.

You do not have to appoint the same attorneys for your health and welfare LPA and for your property and financial affairs LPA.

You must appoint at least one attorney and can appoint more one attorney if you wish. You can specify that your attorneys have to act together at all times, independently at all times, or that they can act together on some matters and independently on others.

It is important that you carefully consider who you choose as your attorney as an LPA gives an attorney significant responsibilities and

control of your affairs. You should choose someone who you trust, who you can have frank conversations about your wishes with and someone who is able to practically act as your attorney.

OUR FEES

Should you wish to have assistance in the preparation of LPAs, our fees will be charged on a time spent basis in accordance with our hourly rates, however as on outline guide:

Please note that the Royal Court of Guernsey will charge a fee of £80 for the registration of one LPA or a fee of £100 to register both at the same time. The Royal Court will charge no further fees if it becomes necessary to activate the LPA.

It may be that you wish to include more detailed and specific instructions in your LPAs. Any instructions outside of a basic LPA will be charged on a time spent basis in accordance with our hourly rates.

You must have capacity to grant an LPA so any capacity concerns will increase our fees.

WILLS

You may also wish to prepare, or update, your Wills at the same time as making an LPA.
